
Qualifications



Our Goal

The goals of the Ministers of Hospitality (Ushers) is to preserve and uphold the dignity of the house of God, to maintain order at all services, and to assist our Pastor in any way possible.

In action, the Ushers try to create a feeling of welcome for all who enter our home, Our Lady of Loretto. We assist the elderly and those in need of handicap access. Ushers meet every parishioner and visitor at the doors with a warm greeting and a smile.

<u>Duties</u>

Ushers arrive early to services to prepare for the arrival of the congregation. They open doors, assist with seating, collect donations, arrange orderly Communion processions, and distribute the Traveler. They take special directions from Fr. Socorro Fernandes Sr. Margretta Wojcik, or other staff members, to reserve certain pews, move the Baptismal Font, or doing anything else that is needed before, during, or after the Masses or other services.

Ushers assist parishioners or guests who may fall ill during the service, including providing assistance to the vestibule or summoning EMS care and transportation when necessary. Ushers try to be helpful and courteous to all persons, by answering questions, providing directions, and accommodating requests when possible and to the best of their ability.

Other Functions

In addition to their duties associated with our Masses, the Ushers conduct fund raising for special projects or to benefit the general fund of the parish. The group also has a social aspect that promotes Catholic fellowship, at our regular meetings and at our annual Christmas party
